
## **EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES**


Multiple Sites, Tri-State Area





From the colonial one-room schoolhouses to the sprawling university campuses of today, construction and expansion of educational facilities has been critical to the development of society at both the local and state levels. Historical Perspectives, Inc. (HPI) has undertaken numerous archaeological and historical studies of former, existing, and future school sites across the Tri-State Area. HPI has evaluated hundreds of properties through on-call contracts for the New York City School Construction Authority, which oversees all public elementary, middle, and high school facilities in the five boroughs.

HPI also has evaluated sites at many of the State University of New York (SUNY) campuses through on-call contracts with the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York, which oversees these projects. Sites have been located at SUNY New Paltz, SUNY Old Westbury, SUNY Oneonta, SUNY Oswego, SUNY Purchase, SUNY Stony Brook, and SUNY Utica.



HPI has undertaken projects at other local campuses, including Columbia University, New York University, and the City University of New York's Bronx Community College, LaGuardia Community College, Medgar Evers College, and the College of Staten Island. Catholic college sites have included Iona College in New Rochelle and St. John's University in Queens. Additional private school projects have included the Wartburg, a former Lutheran school for orphans in Mount Vernon, NY; the Tartikov Rabbinical College in Pomona, NY; and the Stanwich School and Brunswick Academy in Greenwich, CT.
