RECEIVES 2005 AASLH AWARD

Historical Perspectives, Inc., of Westport, Connecticut, has received a 2005 Certificate of Commendation from the American Association for State and Local History (AASLH) for its Archaeological State Preserves Booklet Series.

Historical Perspectives (HPI) created the design for a series of educational booklets for the Archaeological State Preserve program that serves to nominate, preserve and celebrate Connecticut's archaeological heritage. The Preserve program is administered through the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism. HPI produced and distributed the first five engaging educational publications relating to the 17 Preserve sites that range from Revolutionary War encampments to engine houses to shipwrecks. While formulating the template for the booklet series, HPI was responsive to the Preserve community, pulling together various agencies, museums, and schools. Each booklet has been transferred electronically to the Office of State Archaeology, where it will be posted, available to teachers, to students, and to the general public interested in Connecticut archaeology.

The AASLH is a not-for-profit professional organization of individuals and institutions working to preserve and promote history. Founded in 1945 to establish and encourage standards of excellence in collection, preservation, and interpretation, the AASLH awards are the most prestigious recognition for achievement in the preservation and interpretation of state and local history.
